What do you need?



Wallpaper spatula

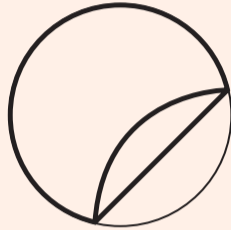
Surface requirements:

For optimal results, the product should be applied to the correct surface. Follow these guidelines:

- **Flat surface:** Ensure the surface is completely flat. This is essential for good adhesion and a smooth finish.
- **Suitable for glass, plastic, and wood:** This product can be applied without problems on glass, plastic, and wooden surfaces. For wood, it is important that it is splinter-free and flat to ensure a durable attachment.
- **Not suitable for textured walls:** If you have a textured wall, we recommend making it flat before applying the product.

Application



- Remove about 20% of the backing at the top. Place the first part on the wall and press it down with a spatula.
- Remove another portion of the backing, working from top to bottom.
- Repeat this process until the entire circle is applied to the wall.

Removing air bubbles

- Work from the center to the edges and press the circle firmly.
- Use a spatula or cloth to smooth out any air bubbles.

3

Finishing

- After the last part of the circle is applied to the wall, press the circle from top to bottom again with a spatula.
- Check the edges and press them well to ensure the circle is firmly attached.

Wallpaper brush

Surface requirements:

For optimal results, the product should be applied to the correct surface. Follow these guidelines:

- **Priming newly plastered walls:** If you have a newly plastered wall, it is important to prime it first. This ensures better adhesion and prevents long-term problems.
- **Not suitable for textured walls:** If you have a textured wall, we recommend making it flat before applying the product.

Application



- Apply a generous amount of glue to the back of the circle.
- Make sure the edges are well-coated with glue.
- Attach the circle to the wall from top to bottom.
- Press the circle extra with a spatula. Work from the center to the edges.

Removing air bubbles

- Work from the center to the edges and press the circle firmly.
- Use a spatula or cloth to smooth out any air bubbles.
